Company shall not be responsible for damages from any such delay.
- 3. TAXES, FEES, AND PERMITS: Customer agrees to pay Company all Federal, State, and local taxes, excises, permits, and fees. All dollars in this Agreement are pre-tax, unless otherwise stipulated.
- 4. SHIPPING: All shipments of equipment are FOB Company's distribution facilities.
- 5. RESPONSIBILITY: Until balance is paid, Customer agrees to take proper care of the Equipment on premises and to be responsible for its damage or loss by fire, theft, casualty, or any other cause whatsoever, and will not permit or suffer same to be removed from the place of its location at address of Customer, without written consent of Company or assigns.
- 6. No modification of this Agreement shall be valid, unless made in writing and properly signed by each party. If the Customer's network is not "Plug and Play," then any custom network settings must be supplied by the Customer to Company before the completion of installation.
- 8. INSTALLATION AND SITE PREPARATION: Installation (field assembly, interconnection, equipment calibration and checkout) is to be performed by the Company's trained technical employees. The Company shall be entitled to employ subcontractors and/or agents to assist in or carry out, in whole or in part, the installation.
